



How have municipal governments responded to these issues?






Affordability Concerns

Have you considered relocating your business away from the Greater Vancouver region due to affordability concerns?




How do you feel about the future of the region in terms of quality of life and affordability?

Would you support an Indigenous-led bid for Vancouver to host the 2030 Winter Olympics?








Housing Planning and Affordability

Has your ability to recruit or retain employees been affected by the cost of housing in the Greater Vancouver region?




Do you think your local government is planning for the housing, infrastructure and services growth required to meet the needs of a growing population?






Should local governments prioritize supply side policies or demand side policies?


Should municipalities in Greater Vancouver consider zoning changes that allow various kinds of multi-family units to be built in areas currently zoned for single-family detached homes?

The provincial government has suggested it will introduce legislation to intervene if cities reject affordable housing projects.








Level of Support for Local Governance Issues

Do you support efforts by municipalities to liberalize or simplify land use regulations to allow more diverse types of development?




Do you think that more coordination between municipalities on economic development and licensing is a positive move?

How do you think local governments should address the diminishing supply of employment lands for industry?




'Other' Responses





Over the past five years, has it become easier or harder to do business in the region?




How would you rank your experiences engaging with local government on issues relating to your business?







How concerned are you/your business about local businesses closing due to rising costs, including property taxes?






