## **BOB RENNIE**

O.B.C.



Bob Rennie will celebrate 50 years in real estate this December. He is the founder and executive director of the rennie group. The rennie brand has redefined the business of real estate, offering specialized sales, marketing, intelligence, information & technology services for over 49 years. Bob is recognized for his leadership in envisioning new and innovative strategies in development risk management and real estate marketing in the development industry. An example of his government and private engagement would be the oversight of the 2010 OLYMPIC VILLAGE receivership. Most recently, rennie was selected to represent Disney for Canadian Sales in a 600-acre development in Palm Springs.

Bob is involved in various philanthropic initiatives focused on mental health and education, along with being an active voice and member of the arts community locally, nationally,

and internationally. Bob has assembled Canada's largest contemporary art collection, recognized as one of the top 200 collections in the world for its masterpieces that explore social justice.

Bob is involved with numerous boards and executive committees. He currently sits on the Board of Directors of VGH & UBC Hospital Foundation. including Head of Major Gifts at VGH and Chair of the Peter P. Dhillon Centre for Business Ethics. He holds leadership roles in prominent art institutions, including President of the Tate Museum's American Acquisition Committee and Chairman of the Collections Committee at the National Gallery in Washington DC, was on the Board of Trustees of the Art Institute of Chicago, where he was chair of modern and contemporary acquisitions for nine years, is the recipient of the Queen's Diamond and Golden and Platinum Jubilee



awards, and recently awarded The King Charles III Coronation Medal, and has an honourary doctorate degree from Emily Carr University.

In 2022, Bob was recognized for handing over the oldest structure in Vancouver's Chinatown, the Wing Sang building, along with a 7.8-million-dollar donation from the rennie foundation. Wing Sang was home to the rennie collection and the rennie group

of companies from 2009 to 2022 after a five-year heritage preservation. Bob, along with all 3 levels of government, attended the opening on July 1st of last year as the 1st Chinese Canadian Museum in Canada. In recognition of Canada's 150th anniversary, Bob handed over 197 artworks worth over \$13 million to the National Gallery of Canada, along with a transformational 20 million dollar gift of 46 works of art just this month.
